An electrical fire in December 1999 destroyed almost the entire contents of the building. However, Trinity had always operated a stringent off site data-back-up system and employees responded quickly with emergency contingency plans. Trinity's customer support 'down-time' only amounted to two hours, and employees worked over the 1999 Christmas period setting up in temporary premises at Regent House, Stockport. Amazingly, the consequences of the fire had virtually no detrimental effect on any of Trinity's 80 customers.

Over the past 12 months, Trinity has been running to a tight schedule to rebuild their premises at Bredbury, and now they are please to announce their return to Bredbury Park. Their new purpose built premises houses over 70 employees and covers 13,000 square feet.
